With over 260,000 Project Management Professionals worldwide, the Project Management Institute's certification program is now a standard across all industries. Becoming a certified Project Management Professional (PMP®) involves satisfying the following education and experience requirements, and passing a 200-question exam:

- 35 hours of project management education plus *either*
- a high school diploma (or equivalent) and 7500 hours of project management experience *or* a bachelors degree (or equivalent) and 4500 hours of project management experience.

The key to passing the exam is to understand PMI®'s view of project management. This means reviewing and understanding PMI's Body of Knowledge (PMBOK®), and becoming familiar with how PMI expects project managers to apply that knowledge. In most cases, this requires PMP-candidates to become familiar with new concepts during their PMP exam preparation, and/or to "unlearn" practices they have picked up over the years.

Who should take this course?

- Individuals wishing to obtain an international credential demonstrating an understanding of the fundamental, best practice, project management knowledge defined in the PMBOK.
- Individuals looking to advance their standing as project management subject matter experts in their organizations.
- Individuals working to support or establish a project management office.
- Project managers looking to formalize their project management skill-set and be recognized for their project management knowledge.

Course participants should be familiar with the certification process, and meet the PMP experience requirements prior to attending. You should also be reasonably familiar with modern project management techniques, as advocated by PMI, and be planning on sitting for the exam within a couple of months of completing this course.

Course Objectives

By the end of the class you will be able to:

- Understand PMI's approach to project management.
- Understand how the PMP exam is structured, and what kinds of questions will be asked.
- Be very familiar with all sections of the PMBOK.
- Possess various tricks, tips, techniques, & templates
- to help you retain information for the exam.
- Note : The actual PMP exam itself must be scheduled and undertaken separately from this preparation course. Fees, payable directly to PMI, are incurred for the PMP application process and associated exam.
